### Platinum Club for Seniors

The Platinum Club is a free hospital-sponsored program for all Glenn County residents 60 years of age and older. Seniors are invited to attend these monthly presentations with their friends and neighbors. Please join us on **Thursday, June 23rd**, in the GMC large conference room at 9:00am for a delicious breakfast provided by our Dietary Department. At 9:15, Nick Wessel, Senior Specialist from the Disability Action Center (DAC) in Chico, will be presenting information on the "**Free Vision Resources Program**" through DAC. This is a non-profit, grant-funded organization that helps people in Northern California to achieve and maintain their maximum level of self-reliance and independence. Their Vision Resource Program is available to SENIORS (55+) living with a severe visual impairment. The majority of the time, their clients will have conditions such as Macular Degeneration, Cataracts, Glaucoma, or Diabetic Retinopathy. To be eligible for the program, the only requirement is that one must be over the age of 55, and have low or no vision. Through the Vision Resources Program they can give their clients free assistive technology, large print items, and helpful information and referral to free/low cost resources. For example, they have giant print calendars and address books, talking devices to help tell the time, writing tools, applications for free government phones, talking book players, and other various technologies that help the visually impaired live independently. We will have some brochures with more information regarding their organization and the Vision Program on hand. We expect this to be a popular event and seating will be limited so make sure to call and reserve your spot. **Please RSVP to Deborah at 934-1881** to make sure we have enough seats and treats for all.
